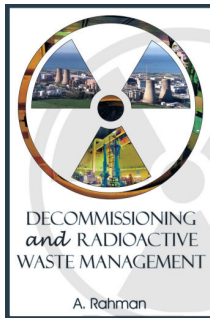

Timely new book for the nuclear industry –

Decommissioning and Radioactive Waste Management



To be published in March, this major text is the most comprehensive and up-to-date book dealing with all aspects of the subject, from radiological protection and nuclear safety to legislation and practical issues. The author, Dr Anisur Rahman, has many years experience in the nuclear industry and has been instrumental in creating courses on these topics in the UK and Europe. He therefore recognises the need to maintain a balance between academic knowledge and industrial experience which will help workers perform these activities safely, securely and cost-effectively and enable students to fully appreciate the complexities of this vital discipline.

In the first of three parts the book deals with the necessary radiation science and biology and how both people and the environment can be protected from the effects of radiation. Key statistical methods and calculations conclude the chapter, which also includes worked examples. Revision questions can be found in this and most chapters. The diverse aspects of decommissioning are covered extensively in part two – where chapters deal with the safety, regulatory and financial aspects before tackling the vital issues of planning, environmental impact assessment, site characterisation, decontamination and dismantling techniques. This part of the book concludes with case histories and lessons learnt – critical in the consideration of any future project. Part three completes the book logically with a detailed appraisal of radioactive waste, from its classification, management and treatment, to storage, transport, and ultimate disposal.

This book provides a wealth of information for anyone who could benefit from a comprehensive overview of the subject, whether already involved in this sector or studying with the intention to join. With the current status of energy supplies and climate concerns, this is indeed a timely book.
